What to visit in Tavernes de la Valldigna



Torre de Guaita

Built in the 16th century, this tower was part of the defensive system that protected the Valencian coast from Berber pirate attacks.



Clot de la Font

A natural spring surrounded by lush vegetation, perfect for spending a day in nature. Every July, it hosts the traditional porrat festival.



Monasterio de Santa María de la Valldigna

Founded in 1298 by King James II, this Cistercian monastery has been restored since 1991 and is one of the main historical landmarks of La Valldigna.



Cova del Bolomor

A Paleolithic archaeological site of great scientific value, offering guided tours and workshops to discover the life of Europe's earliest inhabitants.



Playa de Tavernes and Playa de La Goleta

Family-friendly beaches with fine sand and natural dunes, awarded the Blue Flag and featuring accessible areas for everyone.



Mirador de Sant Llorenç

A natural viewpoint located 350 meters above sea level, offering stunning views of the valley and the sea. Here stands the hermitage of Sant Llorenç, where festivals and concerts are held every August.
